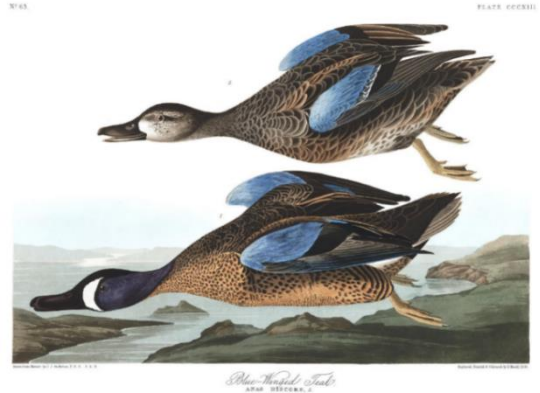

Program:

The illustrations of John James Audubon (namesake of the Audubon Society) in his seminal work *Birds of America* (1827) provided an early standard for the balance of science and art found in nature illustration today. **Tom Schultz**, renowned bird illustrator from Green Lake, Wisconsin, is one of the primary artists for many modern bird field guides, including *National Geographic Field Guide to the Birds of North America* and Houghton-Mifflin's *Peterson Series Field Guide to Warblers*. Tom, a UW-Madison graduate, is an avid birder and former president of Wisconsin Society for Ornithology. His program entitled "The Art of Field Guide Illustration" will provide a behind the scenes look at the process of researching and creating illustrations for bird field guides.
