## OLD WORLD SPARROWS (PASSERIDAE)

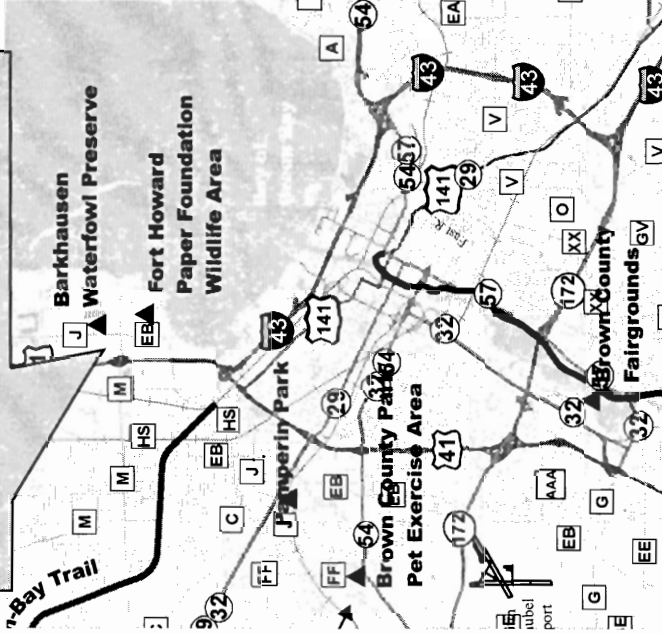

Over nine miles of well-maintained hiking/skiing trails allow you to explore marshes, forests, fields, and a restored prairie along the west shore of Green Bay. Trails are open sunrise to sunset. The Interpretive Center is open 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 12:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday (closed holidays). The center offers educational displays and exhibits as well as a variety of local animals to view up close.
